



Applicants in the course who can demonstrate having attained:

1. An Australian HSC qualification
2. An Australian Certificate IV level qualification delivered in English or higher
3. An Australian Higher Education qualification delivered in English
4. A recognised English language testing result of ILETS 5.5 or higher

are exempt from the requirement to complete an LLN Assessment, all others will required to attend the Gills College office to complete a Language Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) indicator task prior to entry to the course. The LLN Indicator task will need to be witnessed by the trainer, the CEO or our administration staff. This witnessing is necessary to confirm the authenticity of the response, thus the LLN task cannot be taken away to be completed.

Applicants who do not perform well in the LLN Task will be:

- Offered a section of the text book to review and to advise on its content. If the participant cannot understand the contents of the text book, they will be treated as having not yet met the requirements of the LLN task and will be not allowed to undertake the course and could be referred to a TAFE or other English Language service convenient to their home or work.

Only applicants who have completed the LLN task will be accepted into our course.

We do not accept payment from a participant until they have completed our LLN task to a standard appropriate for entry into our course.

Applicants will have their application evaluated and if accepted, applicants will be termed participant.
